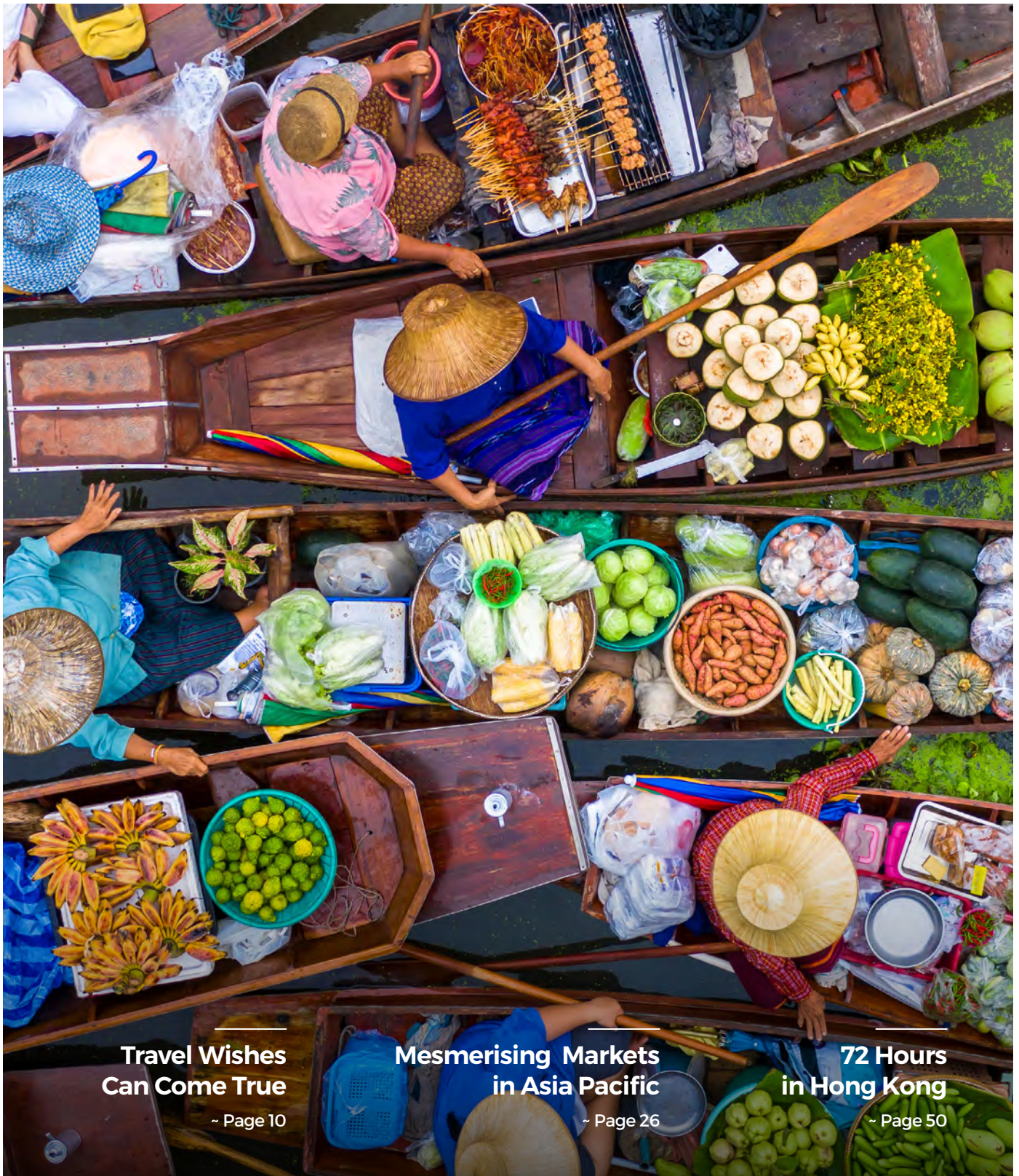

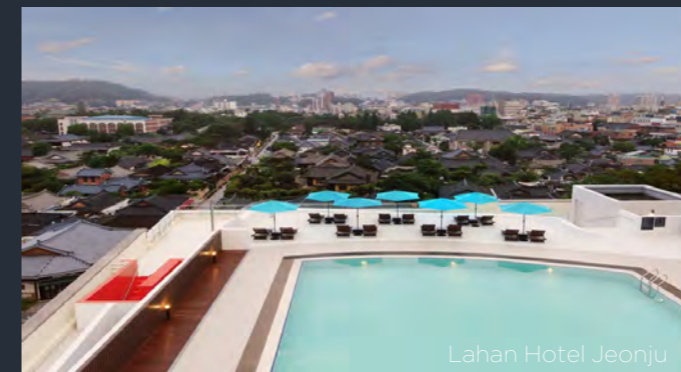

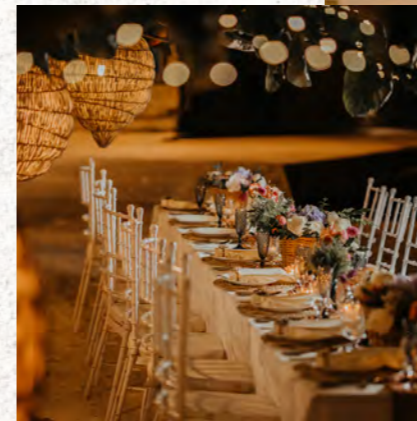

Wyndham Shanghai Nanxiang

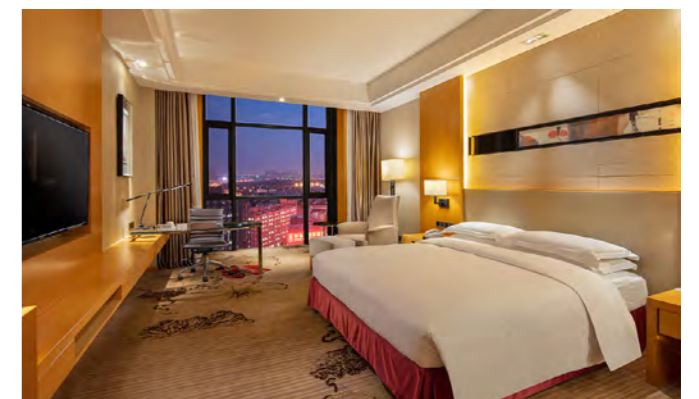

TREVİ FOUNTAIN

ROME, ITALY

This elegant Italian masterpiece, which dates from the 18th Century, is perhaps the world's most famous fountain. Tradition holds that throwing a coin into the fountain (over the right shoulder using the left hand) will ensure that the visitor returns to Rome. Two coins could lead the thrower to a new romance, and three coins mean marriage. Travellers can rest assured that all their coins are collected and donated to charity.

HOTEL WHITE

Hotel White is a stylish upscale hotel in the heart of Rome. Located just a few minutes' walk from the Trevi Fountain, this is a great base from which to explore the city's cultural and historical attractions. After a day of sightseeing, guests can enjoy peace and quiet in soundproofed rooms or unwind at the City Spa & Gym, a holistic wellness center.



CHARGING BULL

NEW YORK CITY, USA

The Charging Bull sculpture in New York City was designed to represent the strength, prosperity and optimism of the "Big Apple". Situated near Wall Street in Manhattan's financial district, it has become an iconic symbol of the USA's fiscal power. Some people believe that rubbing the bull's horns could help to increase their own wealth. Whether it works or not, this still provides an excellent photo opportunity for travellers to NYC!

DOUBLETREE BY HILTON NEW YORK DOWNTOWN

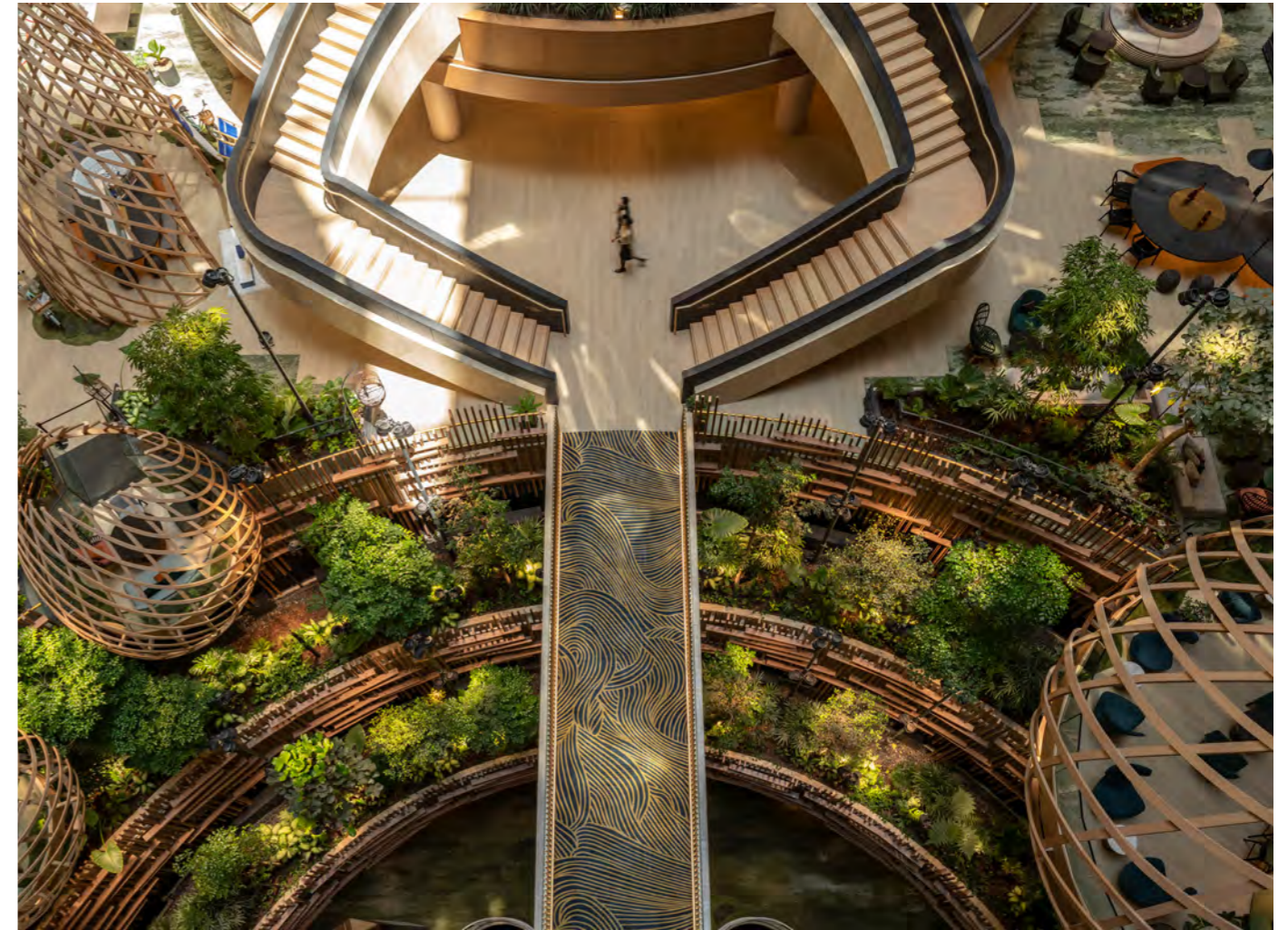

THE FOUNTAIN OF WEALTH

SINGAPORE

The Fountain of Wealth is a spectacular attraction that symbolizes wealth, prosperity and spiritual union. Situated at Suntec City, in the financial heart of Singapore, the fountain features a large bronze ring design based on the Hindu “mandala” (or “universe”). Upon completion in 1998, it was the world’s largest fountain. By walking clockwise three times around the pool, with a hand stretched out over the water, visitors are said to be granted wishes.



 WHERE TO STAY

PARKROYAL COLLECTION MARINA BAY

PARKROYAL COLLECTION Marina Bay is an elegant five-star hotel that blurs the boundaries of nature. This highly sustainable property is home to Southeast Asia’s largest indoor skylit atrium, which contains over 2,400 plants and trees. It also features six restaurants and bars, a world-class spa and an organic rooftop garden and outdoor lounge with stunning city views. The Fountain of Wealth is about 11 minutes’ walk away.



DOL HAREUBANG

JEJU ISLAND, SOUTH KOREA

Jeju's Dol Hareubang statues are an iconic symbol of the island. While their origins remain a mystery, these stone sculptures are said to protect the island and ward off evil spirits. They are also a symbol of fertility; legend has it that newly married women can rub the different parts of the statue to increase their chances of conceiving their desired child – the nose for a boy, the ears for a girl.



 WHERE TO STAY

HAMDEOK BEACH STAY JEJU

Hamdeok Beach Stay Jeju lets guests experience the rich cultural heritage of Jeju Island. Nestled in the heart of the action, overlooking the ocean close to the north coast, this modern hotel features comfortable rooms with balconies and city or sea views, plus an onsite breakfast restaurant and complimentary Wi-Fi throughout. Hamdeok Beach is only a short walk from the hotel.



MEIJI SHRINE

TOKYO, JAPAN

Meiji Shrine symbolizes the timeless Japanese Shinto traditions of respect and gratitude. Visitors to the shrine can write their wishes on “ema” (small wooden plaques) and hang them at the shrine for Kami (God) to receive. Modernised ema designs, such as anime or cartoon-style, are seen to attract younger visitors. Situated in the popular Shibuya district of downtown Tokyo, this is a wonderful place to take a break from the urban hustle and bustle and soak up Japan’s spiritual culture.

CERULEAN TOWER TOKYU HOTEL

Cerulean Tower Tokyu Hotel is a landmark tower in the Shibuya district with a wealth of five-star facilities. Guests can stay in a choice of chic rooms and suites, all on high floors with panoramic views, dine at a choice of restaurants and bars including a teppanyaki room and sushi lounge, unwind at the sauna, spa and indoor swimming pool, or workout at the gym or yoga deck.

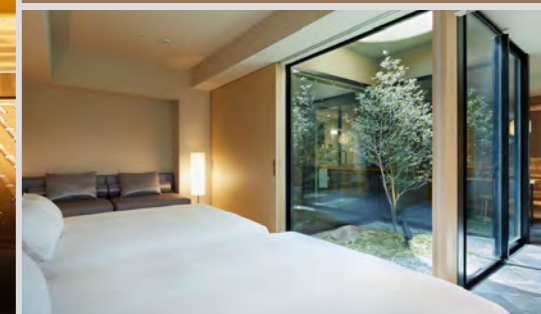

Farmers' Markets

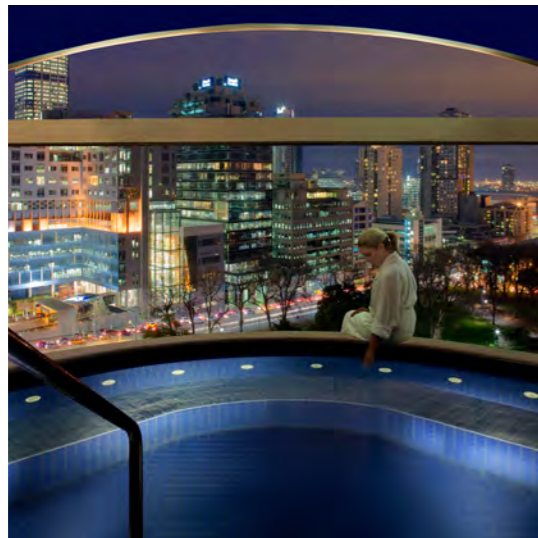

Street Food Markets

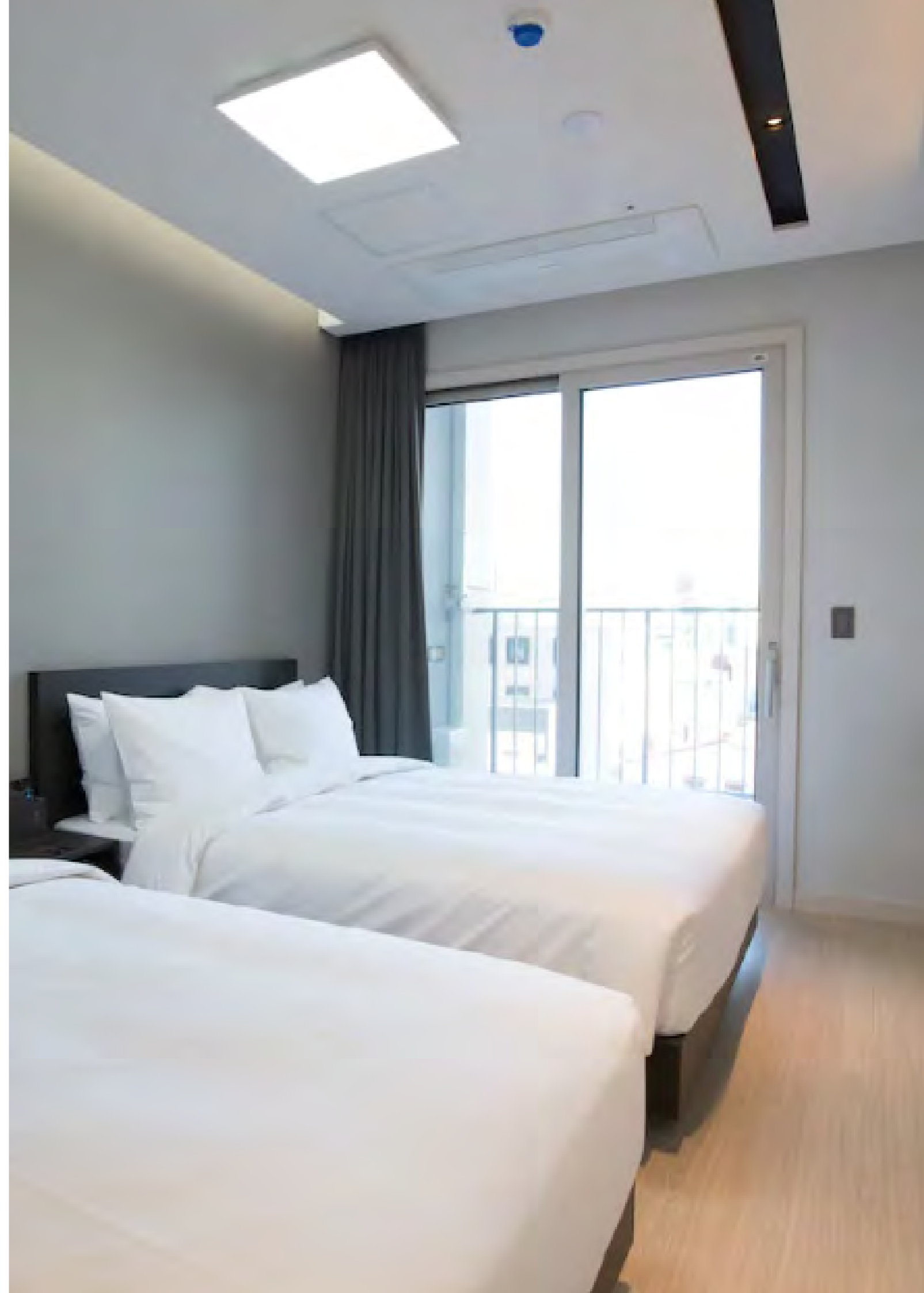
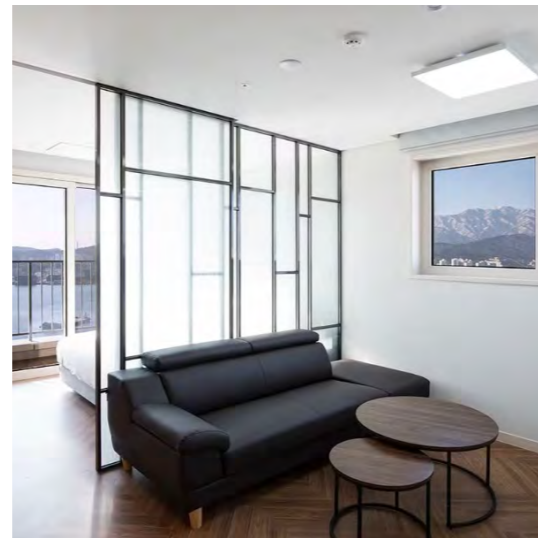

Art Markets

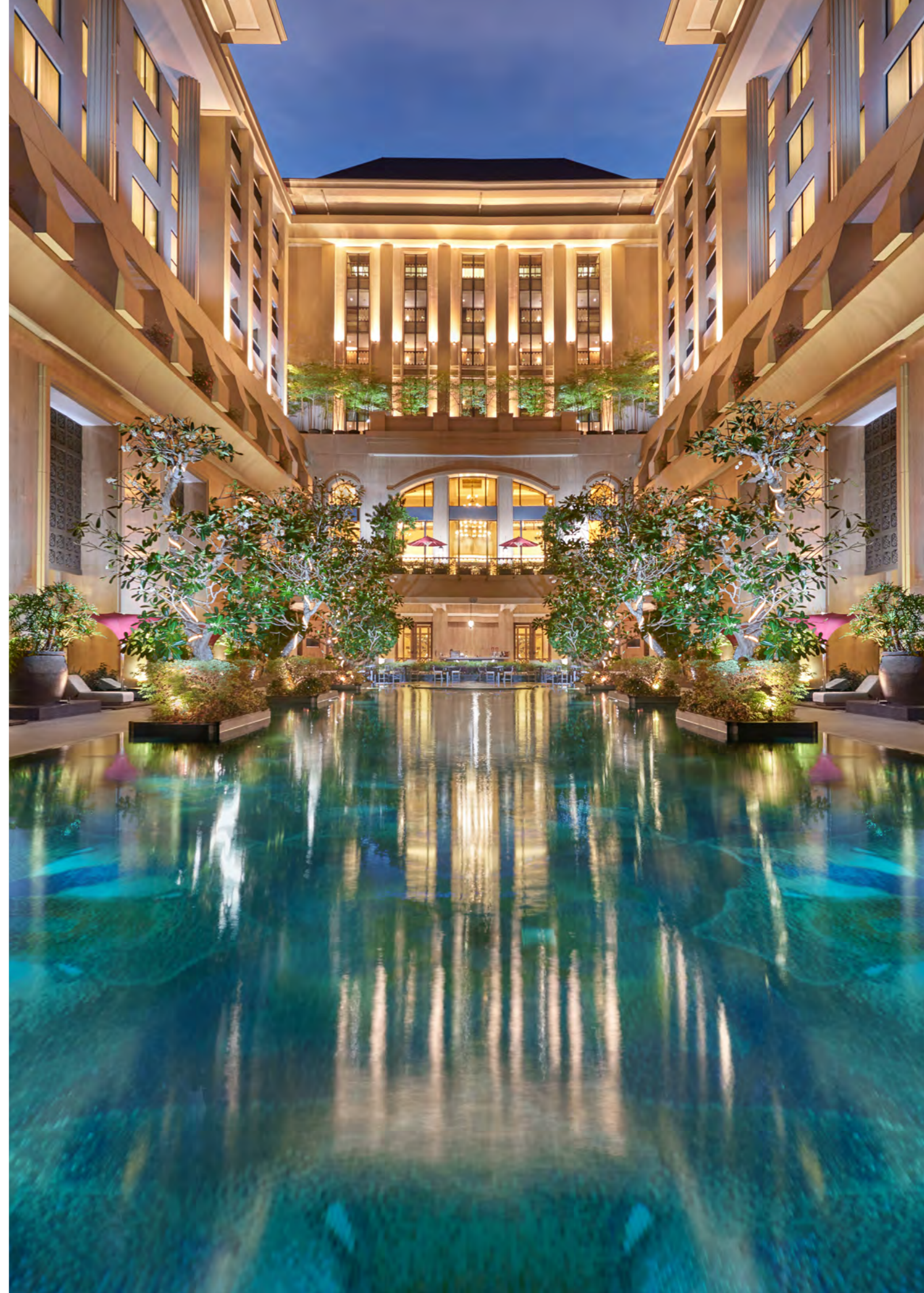
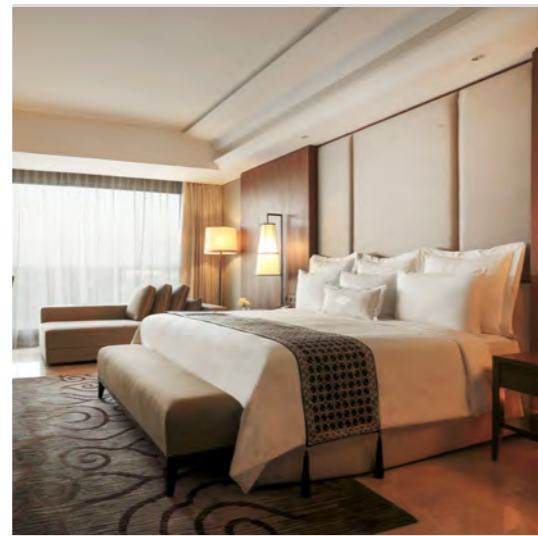

Floating Markets

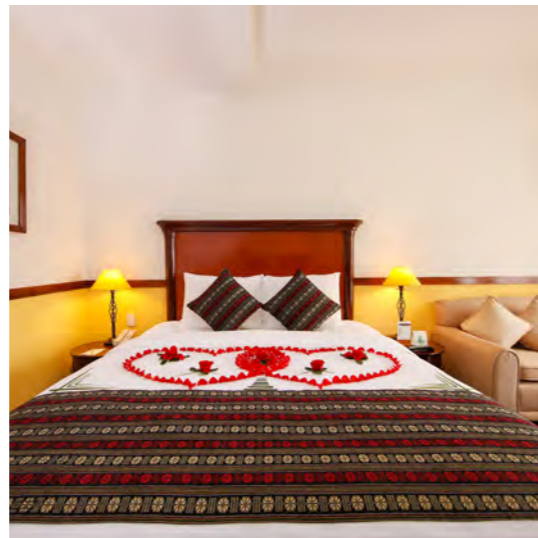
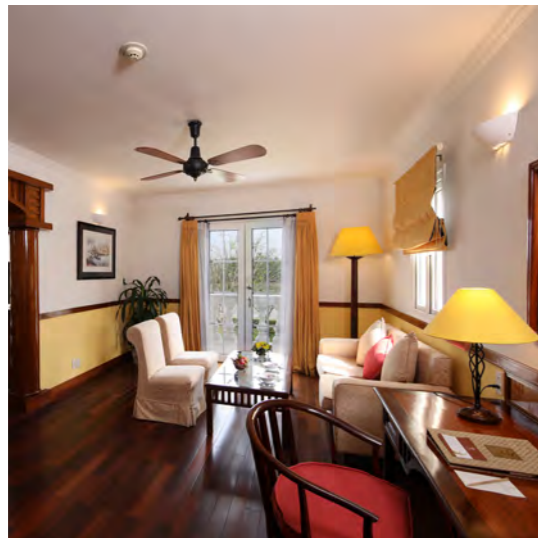

Cai Rang Floating Market has flourished for more than a century, creating a focal point where farmers come to sell their fresh produce to residents and businesses in Can Tho. Come at dawn and savour a traditional Mekong breakfast – a bowl of noodles.

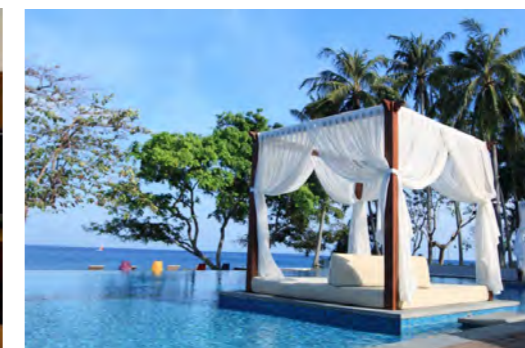
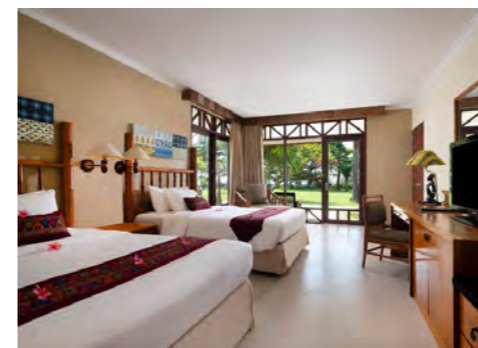

72 HOURS IN HONG KONG

Hong Kong is such a dazzlingly diverse city that it can be difficult to know where to start your urban adventure – especially on a short break. From world-class shopping and dining to captivating cultural sites, mesmerizing markets and thrilling theme parks, it seems impossible to fit everything into a three-day stay. But it is possible!

With the help of WebBeds' insiders, we have crafted an immersive itinerary that encompasses many of the city's top attractions. This is our essential guide to spending 72 hours in Hong Kong.

DAY ONE

Explore Central and The Peak

CENTRAL MARKET

Experience the vibrant sights and sounds of Hong Kong life at Central Market. Located on the site of a historic bazaar that dated from the 1850s, the market was relaunched in 2021 and now houses an eclectic selection of traditional stalls, modern start-ups, co-working spaces and more. This makes it the perfect place to come and soak up the traditional and modern heritage of Hong Kong. Its Bauhaus-style building, which was built in the 1930s, is also a must-see for architecture fans.



THE PEAK

Taking a morning hike up to Victoria Peak – the highest point on Hong Kong Island – is a wonderfully invigorating activity. The cool air and panoramic views of the city and harbour at the summit make the hour-long trek well worth the effort. Alternatively, the Peak Tram, which has been operating for over 130 years, offers a scenic sprint to the top with stunning vistas along the way. Attractions at the summit include parks, gardens, observation decks and a Madame Tussauds.

TAI KWUN

The cultural hub of Tai Kwun is well worth a few hours of exploration. Set in the former Central Police Station compound, this elegant heritage complex has been transformed into a haven of art and design, filled with regular exhibitions, shops and restaurants.



HONG KONG STAR FERRY

For more than 120 years, the Star Ferry has transported people and goods between Kowloon and Hong Kong Island. Today, this iconic harbour crossing has become one of the most used boat services in the world, with a fleet of nine ferries carrying an estimated 50,000 people every day. While many locals will travel on the lower decks, visitors should head up to the higher decks to snap fantastic photos of Victoria Harbour and the surrounding skyscrapers.



LUK YU TEAHOUSE

Hong Kong is a culinary paradise with almost unlimited dining options, ranging from street-side stalls to Michelin-starred restaurants. But don't leave town without trying authentic, handcrafted dim sum, served in towering bamboo steamers at local eateries like Luk Yu Teahouse.

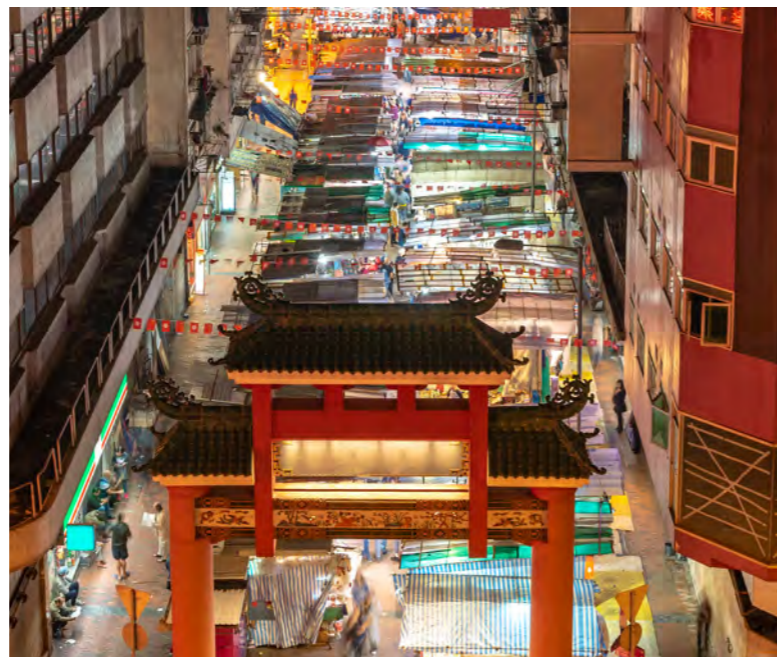
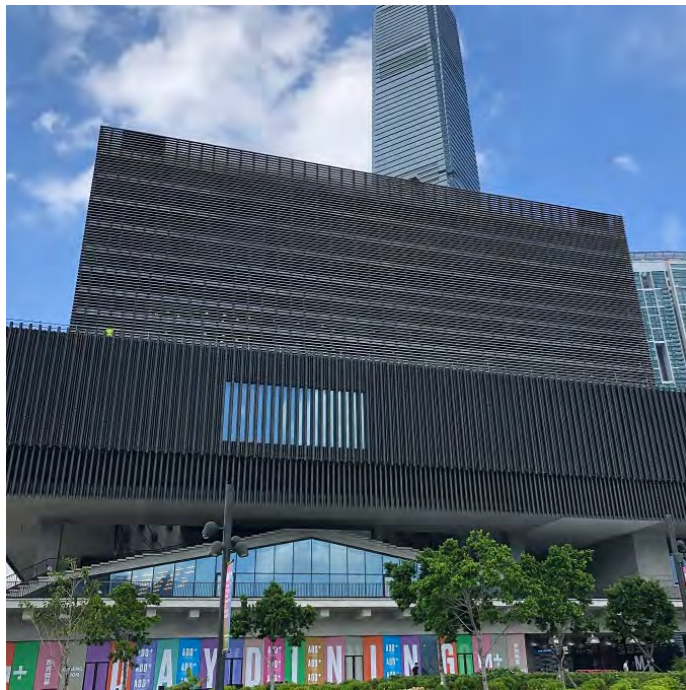


DAY TWO

Be Immersed in Arts and Culture

HONG KONG PALACE MUSEUM

Explore the grace and elegance of Chinese heritage at Hong Kong Palace Museum, which presents over 900 priceless treasures from the Palace Museum in Beijing (which is housed within the Forbidden City), as well as ancient and modern artworks from Hong Kong.



M+

One of the world's largest museums of modern and contemporary visual arts, M+ officially opened in late 2021 and features 33 galleries dedicated to imagery, design, architecture and more, plus three cinemas, a learning hub and roof garden.

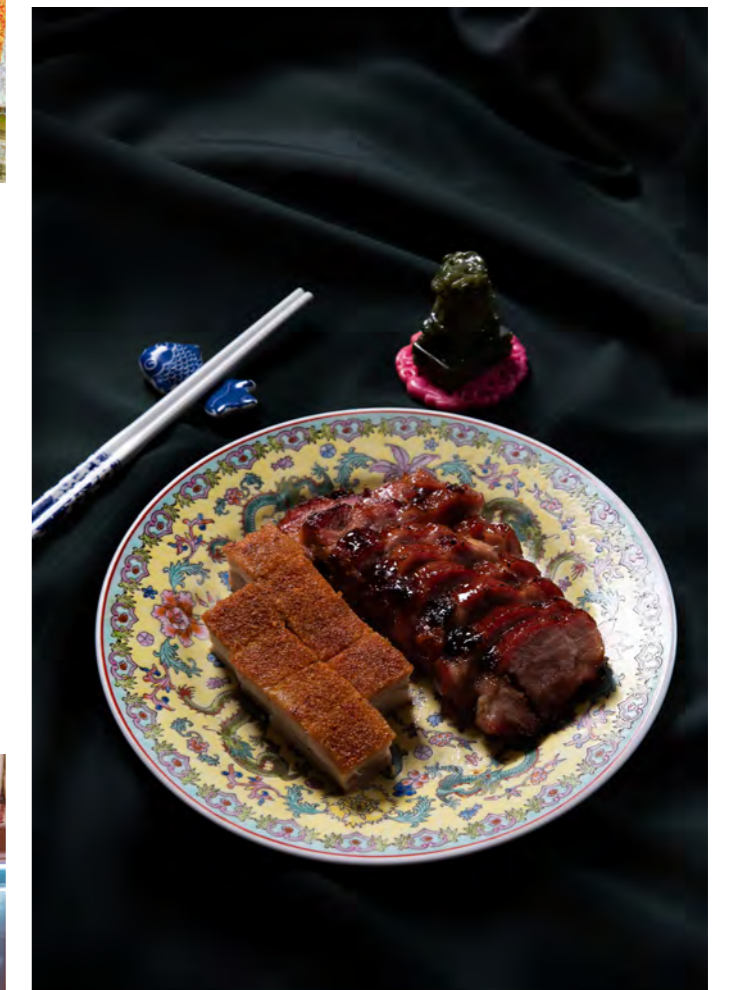


LADIES' MARKET

In the bustling streets of Mongkok, Ladies' Market is a bright and colourful kilometre-long stretch of stalls that sells a wide range of goods, including clothes, shoes, accessories, bags, souvenirs and much more. Despite the market's name, men are also permitted!

TEMPLE STREET NIGHT MARKET

Nestled in the heart of Tsim Sha Tsui, Temple Street Night Market is a vibrant parade of street food, souvenir stalls and other traditional attractions, such as fortune tellers and Cantonese opera, which draw Hong Kong residents and visitors alike. Rub shoulders with locals and soak up the lively atmosphere as you savour freshly cooked delicacies from sizzling stalls, then practice your bargaining skills as you shop for goods ranging from clothing and jewellery to handicrafts and antiques.



YAT TUNG HEEN

Lovers of fine gastronomy can end their day in style at Yat Tung Heen, one of Hong Kong's most celebrated restaurants. Discover an array of authentic Cantonese delicacies and realise why it has been awarded a Michelin star for six consecutive years.

DAY THREE

Discover Lantau Island



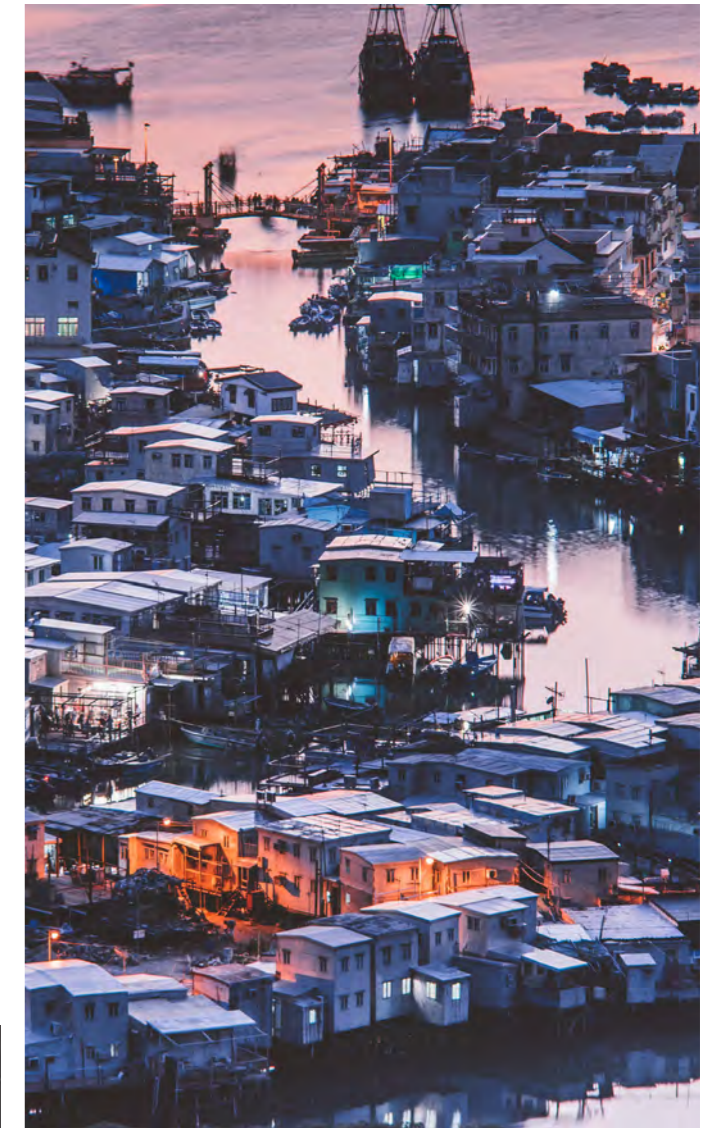
NGONG PING 360

Escape the city and experience the natural and cultural wonders of Lantau, Hong Kong's largest island. This is home to Ngong Ping 360, the popular cable car ride that transports riders over the serene green landscape with spectacular ocean vistas. The Crystal Cabins even feature glass floors for the ultimate bird's-eye view! Ngong Ping Village offers a wealth of other attractions and activities including a cultural centre, plenty of retail outlets and multiple dining options.



THE BIG BUDDHA AND PO LIN MONASTERY

An iconic landmark on the Lantau landscape, Tian Tan Buddha (more commonly known as the "Big Buddha") is a huge bronze statue that sits 34 metres high and can be reached by climbing 268 steps. Located nearby is Po Lin Monastery, which was established in 1906.



TAI-O

The quaint fishing village of Tai-O feels a million miles away from the hustle and bustle of downtown Hong Kong. Perched on stilts above the water at the mouth of the Tai-O River, this charming community features narrow streets, bridges and heritage-listed buildings including centuries-old temples and pre-war shophouses. This is also a natural paradise and a haven of ecotourism; a local boat trip can take you into the river estuary and coastal mangroves. Don't miss the chance to try local seafood.

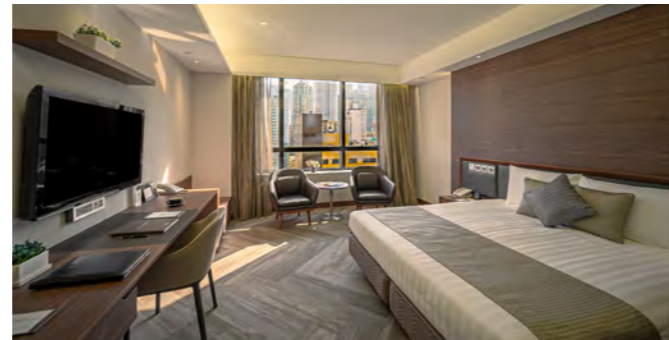


RECOMMENDED STAYS IN HONG KONG



Gloucester Luk Kwok

Gloucester Luk Kwok is located in the Wan Chai district of Hong Kong Island, surrounded by restaurants, shops and galleries. Stay in a choice of stylish upscale rooms and suites with mountain or city views, work out at the fitness centre and dine at a choice of restaurants, including the award-winning Canton Room, one of the most historic Chinese restaurants in Hong Kong which was won many prestigious awards.



Hotel Ease Tsuen Wan

Hotel Ease Tsuen Wan is a modern midscale hotel that offers everything you need for a comfortable and convenient city break. Each of the sleek guestrooms – including a selection of family rooms – comes fully equipped with comfy beds, cable TV, a kettle and fast, free Wi-Fi. There is also a fitness centre, an all-day dining restaurant and a complimentary shuttle service that takes you straight to the nearby MTR station.



RECOMMENDED STAYS IN HONG KONG



Royal Plaza Hotel

Royal Plaza Hotel is perfectly positioned next to a seven-storey shopping complex and on top of MTR Mong Kok East Station, putting the entire city within easy reach. The 699 five-star rooms and suites offer plenty of space and panoramic views. Plunge into the 40-metre swimming pool, unwind at the jacuzzi and sauna, work out at the gym and dine at a choice of four restaurants, including Chinese, Japanese and international options.

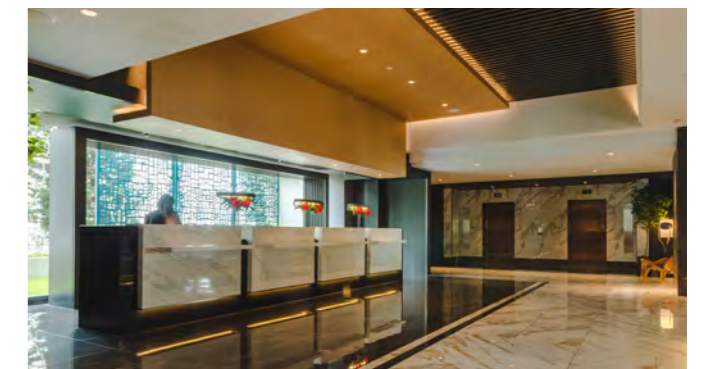
