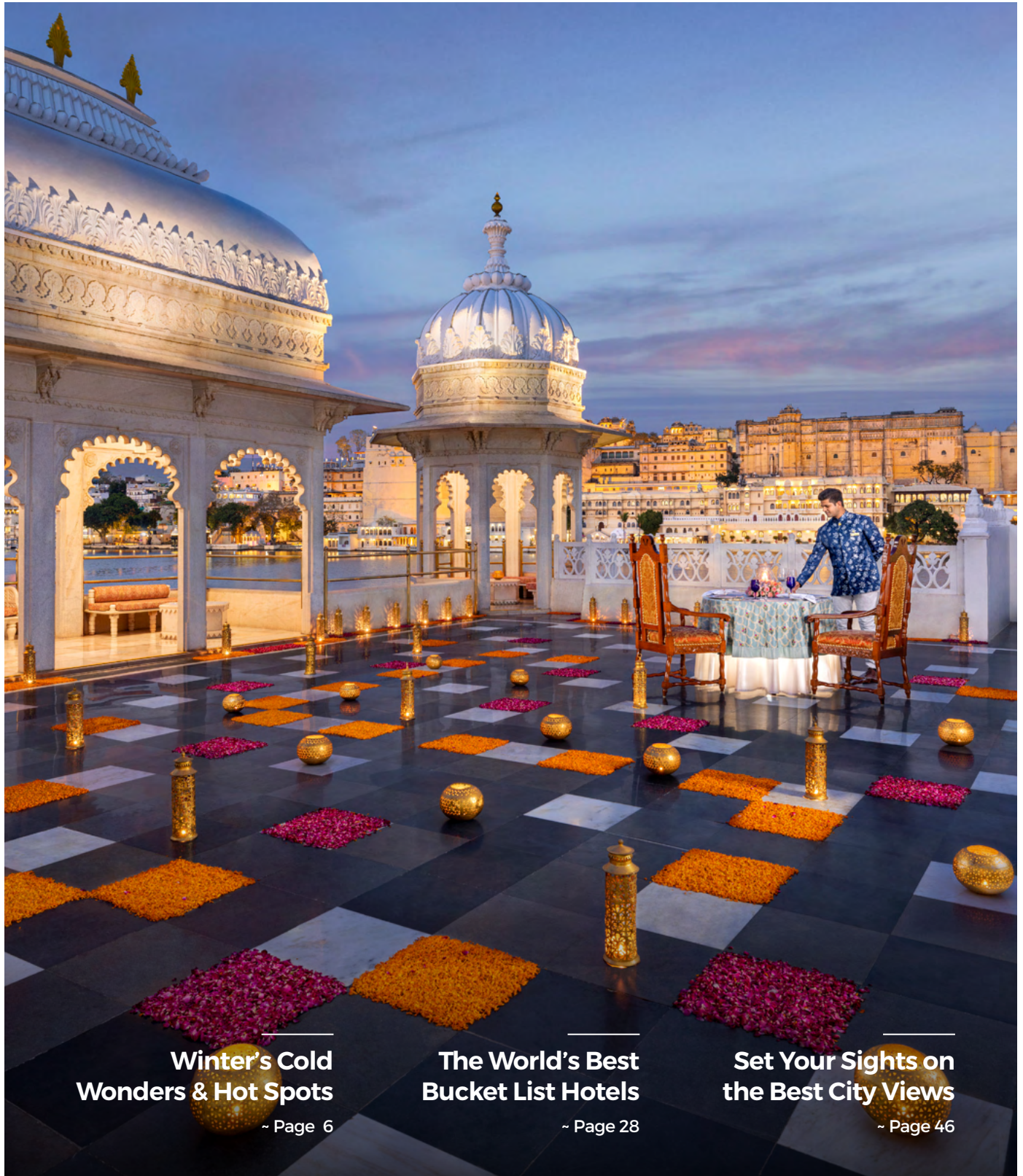

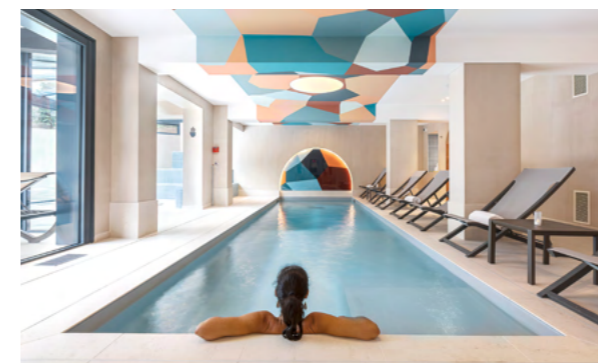
In this article, we tap into the contrasting hot and cold sides of winter travel in dream destinations all around the globe.

FIND MINDFULNESS IN THE WINTER FORESTS OF LUOSTO, FINLAND

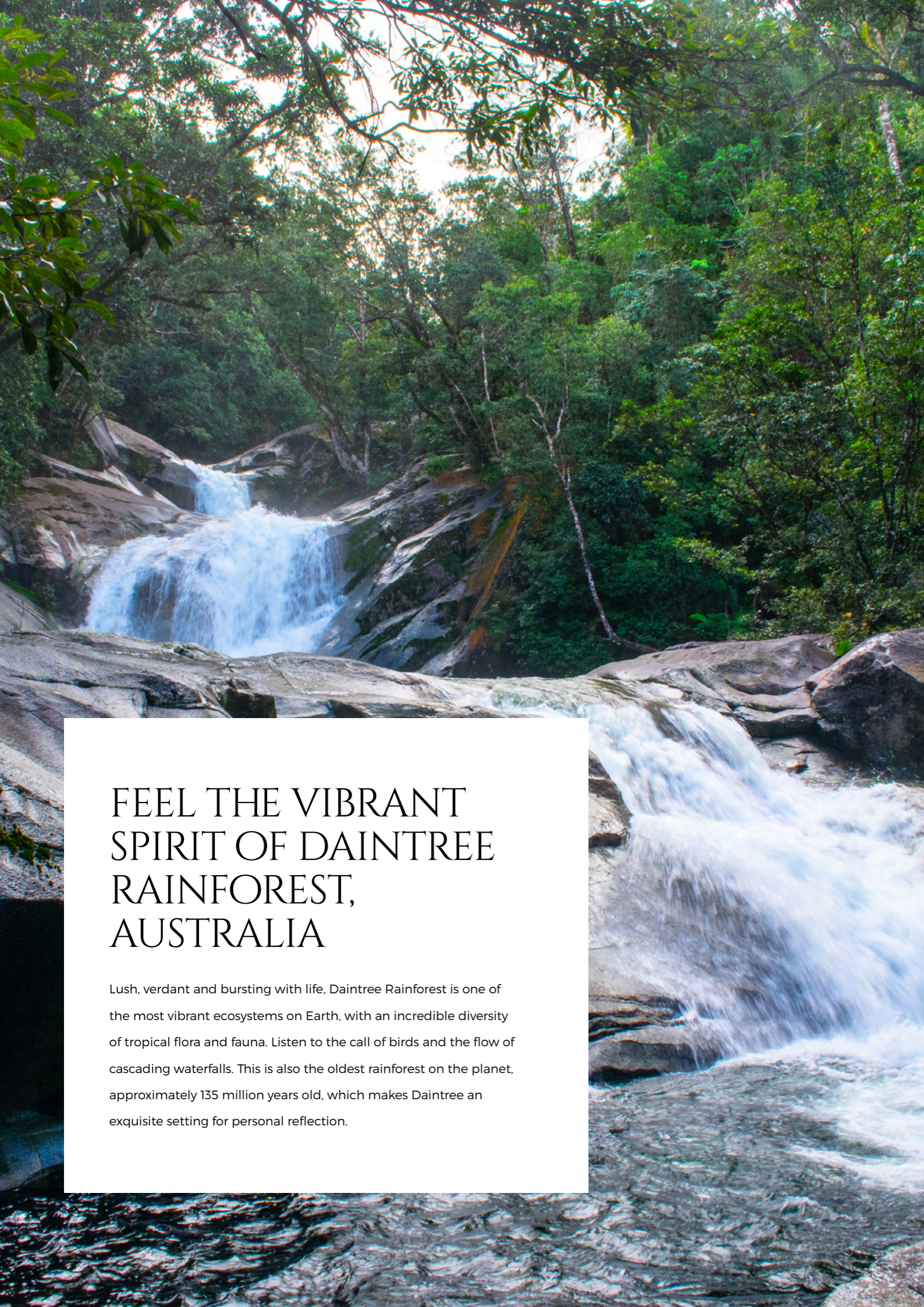

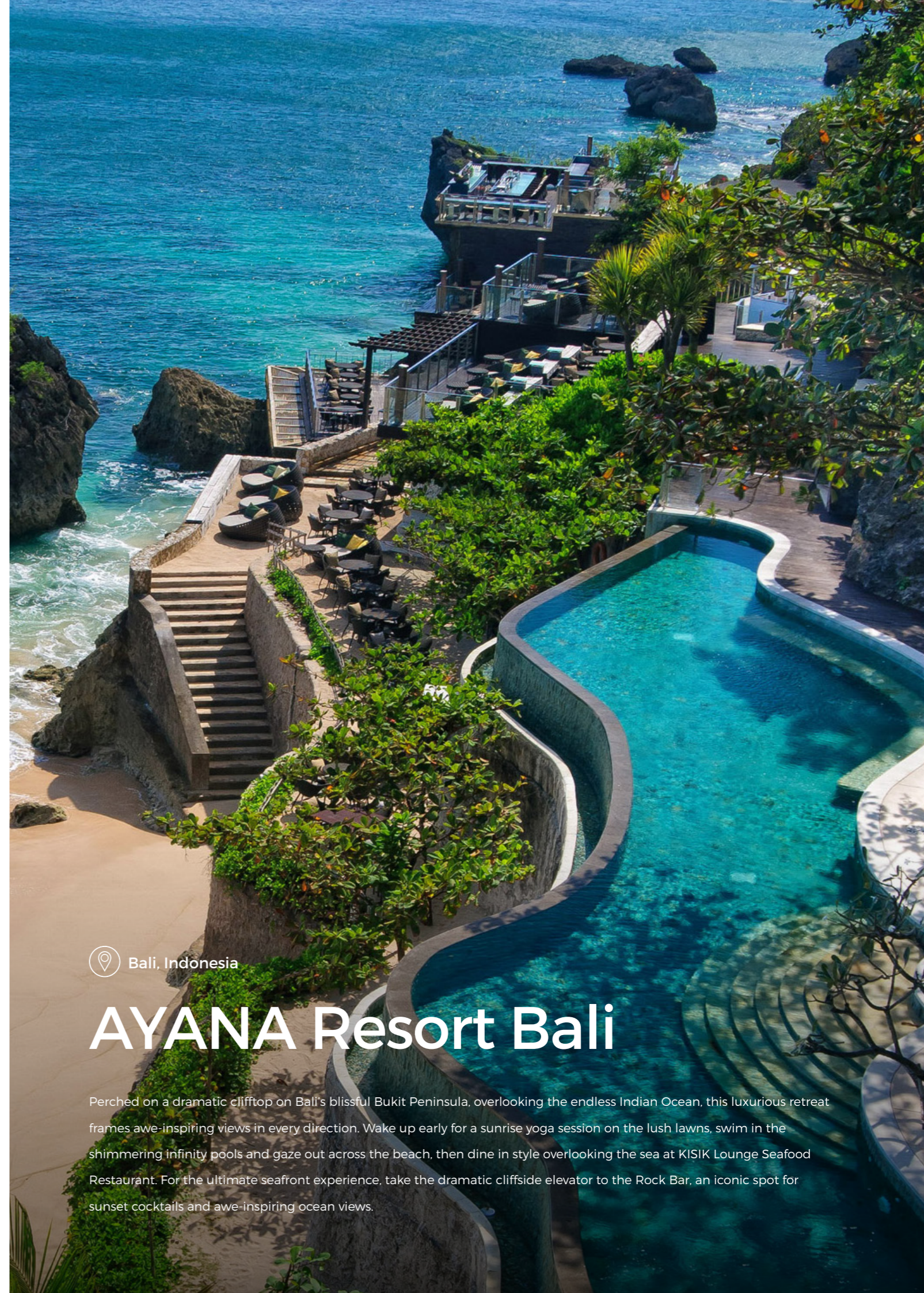



 Chiang Rai, Thailand

 SYDNEY HARBOUR

The best way to experience this heavenly harbour is by boat, with sightseeing cruises available that include long lunches, day trips, dinner cruises or even exclusive private tours. Wildlife lovers can look out for dolphins, penguins and even humpback whales.

Rydges Sydney Harbour

HEAD UP TO AN OBSERVATION DECK

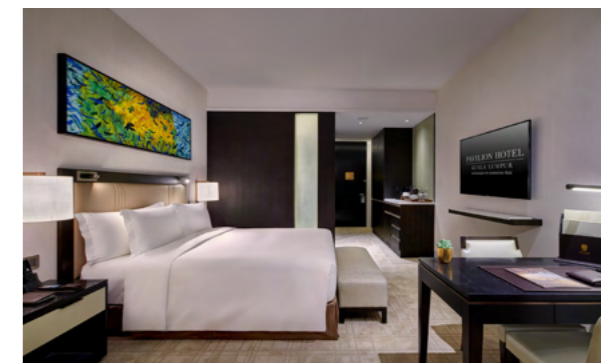

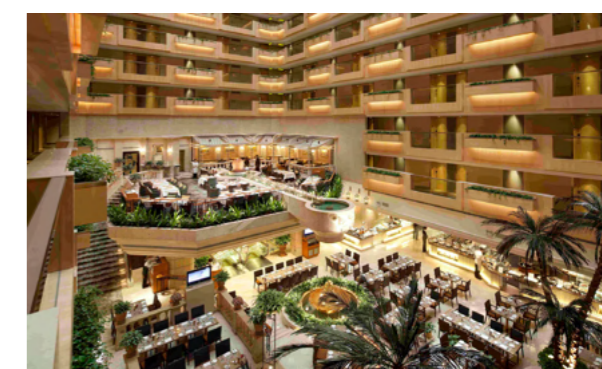

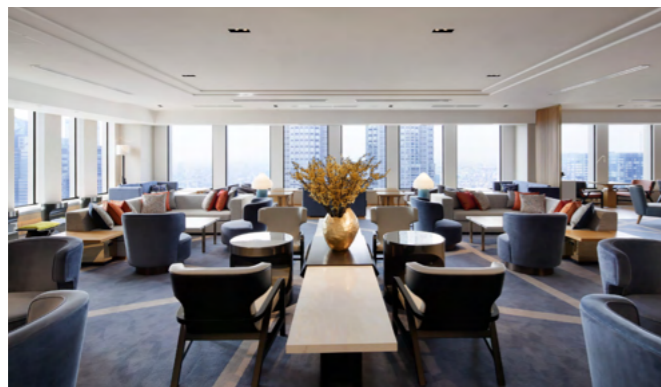
